

## Accessing Cases from the Society for Case Research

The Society for Case Research publishes three case journals:

1. *Journal of Critical Incidents* – once per year in December
2. *Journal of Case Studies* – Two or three issues per year
3. *Business Case Journal* – One or two issues per year

**To review a case** for possible adoption (all are free):

1. On the SFCR.org website, go to the “Publication” tab and select one of our three journals. Each journal page has an index of available cases.
2. Search a library database such as Business Source (Ebsco) for the case.
3. Connect with a content aggregator including Ignited.Global, McGraw Hill Create or Xanadu.edu. All provide access to the case, and some include the teaching note.

**To adopt a case** for a class (subject to fee):

1. Use a content aggregator including Ignited.Global, McGraw Hill Create or Xanadu.edu to build a course pack for your students.
2. Note that adopters are eligible to receive the teaching note for a case.
